# Items for Accreditation Update April 4, 2011 Visit

### **Recommendation 1**

- Update on timeline: resource requests validated by Program Review Committee and IPCC, sent to Budget Committee for prioritization by governance committees [bullet points a, e]
- In the Fall 2010 faculty/staff survey, 78 percent of all respondents and 90 percent of full-time faculty respondents said they are aware of the new process integrating planning, program review, and resource allocation; 65 percent of all respondents and 79 percent of full-time faculty respondents said they had seen a presentation about the revised process. In contrast, in the Fall 2009 survey, 55 percent of all respondents and 53 percent of full-time faculty members said they understood the budget process. [bullet point h]
- IPCC began evaluating the process itself in March, starting with a list of potential process improvements to consider [bullet point b]
- Program Review Committee began evaluating the process through an exit survey of participants [bullet point b]
- The Budget Reallocation Task Force began meeting on [date] to look at accounts over \$7,500 for possible reallocation and reprioritization [bullet point c]
