



Writing Center

Provides tutoring for students who need help in improving their general writing skills and who are working on specific papers or projects. Staffed by writing technicians and student tutors, the Writing Center helps students with organization and mechanics.

Instructional Media Lab

Offers self-paced instructional software and videos for students to improve or build skills in mathematics, writing, and reading. Students may also borrow instructional videos for use at home.

Service Learning Center x5789

Assists students in finding community service, service learning, and volunteer placements in the community. Students can choose from approximately 200 non-profit organizations in the Glendale and greater Los Angeles area. Orientations, trainings, and reflection sessions are also offered as part of various programs.

Student Employment Services x5908

Assists students in finding on- and off-campus employment. Glendale Community College participates in several work study programs, with a large number of on-campus positions

available for currently enrolled students. Students who work on campus are more likely to remain in school and be successful.

Student Health Center x5909

Paid for by Student Health Fees, no appointment is necessary for nursing services which include blood pressure screening, immunizations, health assessments, first aid, crisis counseling, consultation and education. Mental health counseling, physician visits, and nurse practitioner services are available by appointment.

Transfer Center x5928

Assists students with the process of transferring to four-year colleges and universities by providing counseling and advising, workshops and transfer day and evening programs. The Transfer Center is especially committed to the goal of increasing the transfer rate of under-represented students to institutions of higher learning.





Student Services at GCC

Glendale Community College recognizes that there are many activities and programs outside of the classroom which enhance the learning process. Because of this, we work hard to provide friendly, professional attention to students in their pursuit of activities that may be experienced as part of college life.

Numerous student support services have been established at GCC to help students move towards the attainment of goals and add value to the college experience. These programs are designed to assist students in the decision-making process by helping them identify and clarify personal, career and educational goals. Students are encouraged to seek assistance for any issue that may be affecting their college career whether the concern is academic or non-academic.

Assessment Center x5329

Helps students determine their skill levels in many academic areas including written English expression, reading and mathematics with a comprehensive assessment program. Scores assist the students and counselors in determining the appropriate courses for students to enroll in.

Associated Students of Glendale Community College (ASGCC)

The official student government organization of Glendale Community College. Elected each semester, the ASGCC Legislature meets weekly to coordinate programs and services that benefit students, determine budgetary expenditures, and establish and review policies.

Bookstore x3015

Offers a wide selection of textbooks, reference books, school supplies, clothing, software and gift items. Independently run by professional managers and staff, the store's income is used to promote the programs of the Associated Students.

Career Center x5407

Provides individualized career counseling, as well as mini-workshops and classroom interaction to help students find college majors, use career resources, learn of choices for further academic training, as well as learn resume writing and job interviewing skills.

Counseling x5918

Professional counselors are available to assist students in deciding upon an educational objective and determining the courses and services needed to achieve this objective. It is important for all students to complete a Student Educational Plan as students who do so are more likely to meet their goals.

Center for Students with Disabilities (CSD) x5905

Students with verified disabilities, or health impairments are eligible for services through the CSD. Qualified students receive disability services and accommodations to assist them in the pursuit of academic, vocational and personal goals.

Extended Opportunity Program & Services (EOPS) x6900

Provides programs and services designed to afford educationally and economically disadvantaged students the opportunity to participate fully in the educational program of the college.

Financial Aid Office x5916

Assists students seeking financial help to pay for the costs of attending Glendale Community College. Grants and loans are available to cover the cost of enrollment fees and/or tuition, books, transportation, and partial living expenses.

Learning Center x5333

The Learning Center includes the Tutoring Center, the Writing Center and the CAI Lab.
