Board Policy

Parking and Traffic Regulations

Vehicular Traffic and Parking are regulated in accordance with the California Vehicle Code and by Special Rules and Regulations, adopted by the Glendale Community College District Board of Trustees, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Sections 21113 (a, b, c & f).

Parking and driving on District controlled property will be by permit or special permission in accordance with the Glendale Community College District traffic and parking regulations.

Under the general direction of the Vice President of Administrative Services, the District's Chief of Police will have the responsibility for the day-to-day administration and operation of traffic, parking and other regulations which affect the safe and efficient flow of vehicular and pedestrian traffic as well as the enforcement of regulations thereof.

The following are Board Policies regarding parking and other modes of transportation on campus. Violators of these policies may be cited by members of the District's Police Department.

#101 Display of unauthorized permit / Misuse of permit

The display or possession of any permit by an unauthorized person or vehicle and the altering or duplicating of any permit is prohibited and subject to citation, removal and fine.

#102 Parking over 72 hours

Parking on District property, including leased space, for more than 72 hours is prohibited and subject to citation, removal and fine.

#103 Parked blocking driveway

Parking any vehicle, attended or unattended in a driveway or entrance way is prohibited and subject to citation, removal and fine.

#104 Parked / Stopped impeding traffic

Parking or stopping of a vehicle in any driveway, entranceway or road, attended or unattended in such a manner that would obstruct the road or cause other vehicles to detour is prohibited and subject to citation, removal and fine.

#105 Double Parking

Parking of a vehicle in a roadway adjacent to another parked vehicle in a manner that obstructs traffic or blocks the parked vehicle from entering the stream of traffic is prohibited.

#106 Temporary permit expired

No vehicle shall park in any space requiring a permit with an expired permit displayed.

#107 No valid permit displayed

No vehicle shall park in any space requiring a permit without a valid permit displayed. Paper permits must be displayed, face up on the dashboard. Plastic hangers must be displayed on the rearview mirror so that it can be viewed from the rear of the vehicle. Convertibles shall display a sticker permit on the inside of the lower left corner of the front windshield. Motorcycles shall display a sticker permit on the front left fork.

#108 Parking – Red – Yellow – Green zones

Parking in a red zone is prohibited. No vehicle shall park in any loading or unloading zone painted yellow unless they are loading or unloading. No vehicle shall park in any time limited parking area painted green for more than the allowed time posted.

#109 Parked in reserved space without permit

No person shall park a vehicle in a reserved space that is marked as such unless they have a permit specific to that space.

#110 Parked contrary to marked space

When markings are in place designating spaces or the angle for parking, as provided in this regulation, no person shall park a vehicle, except entirely within such parking spaces or between lines indicating angle parking.

Whenever the parking of vehicles is required within parallel parking spaces, a vehicle, or combination of connected vehicles, exceeding the dimensions of such a space may also occupy one or more adjoining spaces; provided, that all other provisions of this administrative regulation applicable to each such space must be observed.

#111 Parked within 15' of a fire hydrant

No vehicle shall park within 15 feet on either side of a fire hydrant or in such a way that it obstructs the access or identification of the hydrant.

#112 Parked in a car pool without a special permit

No vehicle shall park in a designated carpool or vanpool space without a valid carpool or vanpool permit.

#113 Parked after denied permission

No person shall park in any lot or space after being directed not to park by a uniformed police employee or by intercom via a communication device at the gate.

#114 Parked on sidewalk/walkway or lawn area

No person shall park or leave standing any vehicle on any sidewalk, walkway, pathway or lawn area without a permit issued for that purpose from the GCC Police Department.

#115 Parked in passenger unloading zone more than the posted time

No person shall park or stop in any passenger loading or unloading zone for longer than the posted time.

#116 Parked in Handicapped zone or space

Pursuant to Section 22507.8 of the California Vehicle Code, it is unlawful for any person to park or leave standing any vehicle in a stall or space designed for physically handicapped persons, if, immediately adjacent to and visible from such stall or space, there is posted a sign consisting of a profile view of a wheelchair with occupant in white on a blue background, unless the vehicle displays either one of the distinguishing license plates or a placard issued pursuant to Section 22511.5 of the California Vehicle Code or to disabled veterans, as specified in Section 9105 of the California Vehicle Code.

#117 Parked blocking Handicapped ramp

No person shall park a vehicle blocking access to a designated handicap access ramp or in any area painted blue adjacent to a handicap parking space.

#118 Parked in employee lot/stall without a permit

No person shall park in any employee lot or space unless the vehicle is displaying a valid permit for that lot or space.

#119 Parked contrary to posted sign

When authorized signs or curb markings are in place on any street, part of a street, or a parking lot, giving notice of parking limitations, no person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle in any such street, part of a street, or parking lot, for a period of time longer than indicated by such signs, curb markings or in a manner contrary to the posted sign or markings.

#120 Overtime parking

No person shall park a vehicle in any space exceeding the posted time allowed for that space or zone.

#121 Skateboarding/Rollerblading/Bicycles and Motorcycles on campus

No person shall ride a skateboard, roller-skates, rollerblades or non motorized scooter on District property. No person shall operate a bicycle in excess of 5 mph while on District property. Bicycles and motorized bicycles shall not be operated on pedestrian walkways or in buildings. Bicycles and motorized bicycles must park only in designated areas. Motorcycles are not permitted to drive in any area that motor vehicles are prohibited from entering except designated motorcycle parking areas.

#122 Unauthorized Parking in Blocked Area - Traversing Cones/Barricades/Gates

No person shall move or remove any area that has been blocked by cones, barricades or gates unless authorized by the GCC Police.

Bail & Fine Schedule

The bail/fines for the above violations are set after review annually, by the Administrative Affairs Committee and are based on similar bail/fines set by the Los Angeles County Superior Court Bail Schedule and other parking enforcement agencies in the county, for similar vehicle code violations. Any changes to the bail/fine schedule shall be approved by the Board of Trustees.
