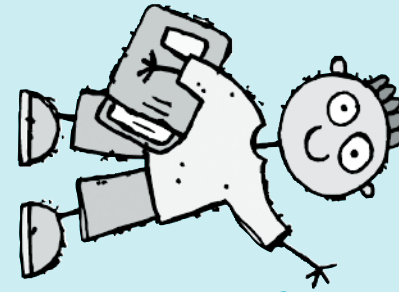
## Daily Schedule

## Class Descriptions

### Creative Writing

Using interesting grade level reading materials of different genres, students will learn easy and applicable strategies for writing to the new common core standards (CCSS). Students will acquire evidence based writing techniques to respond to academic and independent reading. Skills taught will help set the stage for writing success with the new CCSS in all grade levels.

### Reading & Writing

Students will enhance their skills in reading and writing by exploring a variety of literary works and developing a repertoire of written language through poetry, myths, original stories, and other forms of creative expression.



### Fun with Math!

Have fun learning math as we explore and apply mathematics to set up, organize, and operate a Pet Shop! Using concrete manipulatives, problem-solving and hands-on learning will help students better understand basic everyday mathematics concepts.

### Movie Magic!

Grades 4-6. Learn how to make your own movie! Students will work in groups to write, perform, film, edit, and present their very own short movies. This will be done with high-tech video cameras and iMac computers, using apps like iMovie, Garage Band, iTunes, and more. Impress everyone with your new tech skills and creative masterpieces. An additional \$5 materials fee is applicable to this class.

### Weird & Wacky Science

Students will discover and explore the many aspects of science through hands-on investigations, experiments, and activities that will focus on using the scientific inquiry process. Grab your lab coat and sign up for this super summer science adventure!

### Learn How to Code!

Writing code is becoming one of the most exciting and lucrative careers in the world. Studies show that kids who learn to code increase their standardized test scores by up to 30%. Learning to code also increases their abilities in critical thinking and problem solving, the most important skills in Common Core State Standards (CCSS) and 21st Century learning. In this beginners' course, students will learn a format of writing code called BLOCK. They will enjoy being creative as they watch the code they have written come to life when they run their program. Your child will agree, learning to code is fun, engaging, inspiring, and anyone can learn!



### Creating with Clay

Aspiring young artists will learn ceramic hand-building techniques in this fun and creative hands-on class. We will pinch, coil and slab our way through a variety of art projects. Students also learn to decorate their works of art with colorful glazes before firing them in a kiln.

### Cooking Basics for Kids

This class is a recipe for fun! Growing gourmets will have the opportunity to create delicious treats while being introduced to cooking vocabulary and techniques. We'll measure and mix ingredients, use a variety of kitchen tools and utensils, and learn about etiquette, nutrition, safety, kitchen math, and sample new foods.

### Language Arts in Korean

This class is designed to reinforce listening, speaking, reading and writing skills for students. The course is helpful for students who are enrolled in the GUSD FLAG Korean Program at Keppel or Monte Vista, however it is open to ALL students. Please note: the teacher will speak only in Korean during this session. A great opportunity for students who are learning the language or are currently fluent.
