Ms. Rhona Blaker, Coordinator of Contextualized Learning, presented an outline of Glendale Community College's Contextualized Teaching and Learning. She emphasized the importance of a learning environment where teachers relate subject matter content to real-world situations.

Ms. Blaker introduced GCC alumnus and current UCLA, Microbiology, Immunology and Molecular Genetics (MIMG) student, Mr. Luke Butcher. Mr. Butcher shared his experience at GCC and indicated how pivotal it was in shaping his decision about what career path he chose. He noted the Biology 298 course was so inspirational and provided relevant career skills and a hands-on environment.

Board members thanked Ms. Blaker for the information and inquired about what percentage of students were involved in courses using the contextualized learning approach and asked how many sections of Bio 298 were currently offered.
